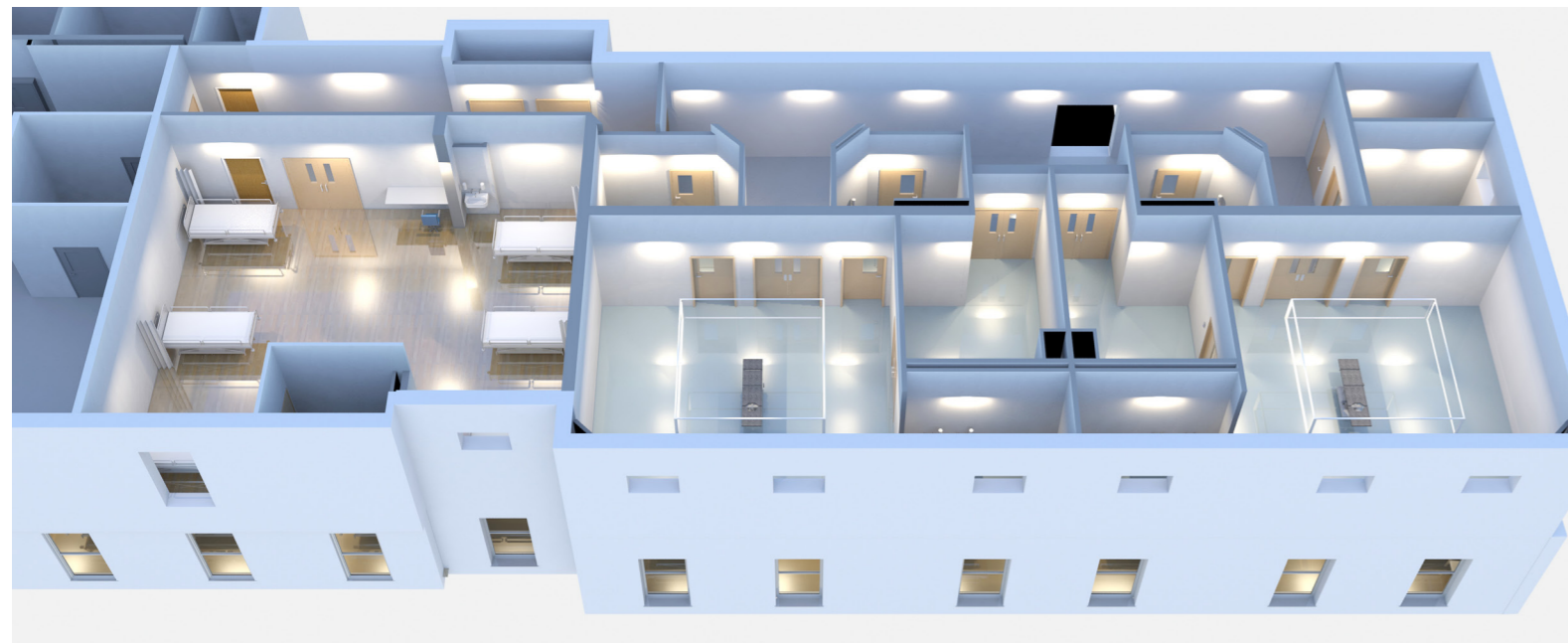

Unique Delivery Methodology

Using our innovative pre-engineered sections, ModuleCo was able to offer a facility which incorporated a ground bearing slab floor, providing an increased structural stability. This unique approach enabled variable building heights, providing the trust with theatres with a 3m FFL ceiling height.



Key specifications:

- 2 full operating theatre suite with a scrub, 49m² operating room, anaesthetic, lay up prep and utility rooms
- 3m internal FFL to ceiling height in the operating room
- Electrical plant room and rooftop plantdeck for AHU
- All Group 1 equipment provided including operating theatre lamp, surgeon's panel and two medical gas pendants in the operating theatre
- Ground floor 10 bed ward
- Second floor 6 bed recovery
- 2No. laminar flow canopies
- Concrete floor throughout the facility
- 60-year structural design life
